#### **BLACK HISTORY MONTH**

Sojourner Truth was an African-American abolitionist and women's rights activist, often known for her "Ain't I A Woman" speech. Born into slavery as Isabella Baumfree in eastern New York, she escaped to freedom with her infant daughter Sophia in 1826 stating that she "did not run off, for I thought that wicked, but I walked off, believing that to be all right." She, however, had to leave her older children behind. New York abolished slavery in 1827, but she found that her son Peter, aged 5, had been sold illegally to an owner in Alabama. With help of a couple she worked for, Isabella Baumfree took the issue to court and in 1828 won her son back, becoming one of the first black women to go to court against a white man and win. On June 1, 1843 she changed her name to Sojourner Truth after joining the Methodist church, stating that she heard the spirit of God telling her to preach the truth.
