

Focus on: BLACK HISTORY MONTH

February is Black History Month and a chance for all Trojans to learn more about black culture and to acknowledge and appreciate contributions made by Black Americans. This week our focus is on significant change makers. Today we focus on Astronaut Mae Jemison. Jemison grew up watching the Apollo airings on TV, but she was often upset that there were no female astronauts. However, Jemison was inspired when she saw an African American actress cast as Lieutenant Uhura on Star Trek and right then, Jemison was determined to one day travel in space. She graduated high school at the age of 16 and moved to California to attend Stanford University. As one of the only African American students in her class, Jemison experienced racial discrimination in school and as a result got involved with campus organizations and served as president of the Black Student Union. On September 12, 1992 Jemison became the first African American woman in space when she was launched on the space shuttle Endeavor. She is fluent in 3 languages and is a physician, teacher, and Peace Corps volunteer. After her work with NASA, she founded the Jemison Group, which develops scientific and technological advancements. Jemison continues to work toward helping young women of color get more involved in technology, engineering, and math careers.
